How to Apply for DCAC

- Ask your spouse/partner (serving family) to apply via Defence Protected Network at this site: [DCAC Portal \(defence.gov.au\)](https://defence.gov.au/dcac-portal) or Form AE294
- Details required are:
 - Full name (including any previous names)
 - Date of Birth
 - Email address
 - Contact phone number
 - State or Territory Access is required
 - Identity Document Number (Australian Passport, Australian Drivers Licence, Australian Proof of Age Card, Foreign Passport or other Government Issued Identity Document)
 - Details of any previous DCAC held
- Your serving family member will need to accompany you to collect your pass
